Find out about plans for I-64 improvements from Settlers Landing (Exit 267) in Hampton to I-564 (Exit 276) in Norfolk. The proposed project will widen this segment of the I-64 corridor from four lanes to six full-time lanes plus two part-time shoulder lanes. A new bridge-tunnel crossing of the Hampton Roads is included.
